




Poly-V-belt (27) mark at clearly visible point with chalk (arrow). crank in stages with starter (01-0110). Poly-V-belt (27) check for signs of damage. Complete procedure once marking (arrow) is again visible (one full belt revolution).

Typical damage


The poly-V-belt must be replaced (subject to separate repair order) if the following types of damage occur: Rubber lumps in base of rib (C), depressions from dirt or grit (D).




 Wear to flanks (F), ribs are pointed – trapezoidal in shape when new (E) and strand visible in base of rib (G, brighter points).




Transverse splits (H) in several ribs.




• Ribs detach from base of belt (arrow).



 Transverse splits in ribs (H) and/or rib material broken out (J).



Strand torn at side (K) or fraying (L) of outer strands.



Transverse splits (M) across the back.
